

Day 1 Flight: Rio de Janeiro (GIG) - Manaus (MAO)

Amazon Speedboat Adventure

3 nights

Day 1)

Cruise on a private speedboat straight from your hotel down river to witness the 'Meeting of the waters', and see mammoth torrents swirl where two giant rivers, the Amazon and Rio Negro converge. Travel up the Negro River (Rio) passing by the famous, floating port of Manaus (built during the last decade of XIX century). Hours later, after having left behind the tourist region, adventurers will enter the vast archipelago region of the Anavilhanas reserve. Here, hundreds of long islands dot the wide Rio Negro.

Lunch is prepared for you on a white sand beach, while you take a dip with the famous Amazonian pink river dolphins, and then it is down river for a spot of Piranha fishing until dusk. Not solely reliant on your fishing prowess, on arrival to your private camp you will find your private home in the amazon has been set up and an enticing piranha soup awaiting. Locally renowned as a famous aphrodisiac, it's effect is only heightened by a champagne and acai bellini.

After dinner, how about a spot of an Alligator 'hunting'?! Your guide will even catch you small one for you to hold, while he explains the alligator's way of life, spot light trained on the water for other nocturnal animals like spiders, snakes, owls or giant frogs.

Day 2)

A delicious breakfast of acai, and its time to pack up and navigate further upstream for several hours by speedboat through virgin, uninhabited islands to the 3 Branches Creeks called Maraja. In these creeks live several families of the local tribe in almost complete isolation. You transfer to wooden canoes for last part of the journey taken to meet the tribe.

In the late afternoon, canoeing is planned until sunset. This area is perfect for paddling into the 'Igarapes' or creeks. The silence you'll experience while canoeing into the tunnel-like creeks is so deep, that you can hear howler monkeys shouting from miles away. Our guides will help you to identify the smells and the sounds during this delightful experience. After dinner, you are invited to head back out in the canoe to do nocturnal wildlife spotting while surrounded by the complete silence of the creeks

Tonight you sleep in luxurious hammocks suspended at camp set up deep into the rainforest. This is a once in a lifetime experience to listen to and try to view nocturnal animals that are not seen during the day: 80% of the animals in the rainforest are nocturnal. If you don't light a fire, animals come very close to the camping spot. This is destined to be up there with the most thrilling nights of your life as you relax under the jungle canopy, refreshingly far away from the 21st century and the daily grind.

.Day 3)

You'll experience an early morning trek deeper inside the rainforest and watch animals like Agoutis, monkeys, and birds wake up. After the guides pack up the deep rainforest camp, you'll hike back to the river and visit a native community. Here you can visit their agriculture fields and learn about the traditional manioc plant processing, a staple crop, and discover how they extract the poisonous liquid from the roots. You can choose if you would like experience more of the industry taking place in the Amazon and meet some of the protagonists on this increasingly important frontier of international business.

Day 4

Back to Manaus where you will be met and transferred to the airport in time for your flight home.
