This BBQ Pit Master class is taught by Chef Paul Kirk, the Kansas City BARON of BARBEQUE. Chef Paul has won the *World Championship of BBQ seven times* and has won nearly *four hundred and seventy-five cooking awards*. Previous students of the Baron's class have said Chef Paul can take three years off trial and error experimenting on your own. Last years class filled up very quickly. This class is suited for the back yard BBQ enthusiast, the seasoned competitor, or those considering opening a BBQ joint (restaurant). The Baron will cover the basics of Barbecuing Brisket, Pork Butt, Pork Ribs, Chicken and Sausage. He will also cover fire management, fuels, BBQ rubs and spices, BBQ sauce, contest presentation, among many other subjects. Students in the Kansas City Baron of BBQ School of Pit Masters will be set up into two-person teams. Students should bring their knives and cutting boards as well as their own pit, with charcoal and woods of choice and anything they deem necessary for the day of barbecuing. If bringing your own pit is not possible, you will be paired with a person who has a pit. All meat and seasonings are provided. Please bring pencil and note pad to the class. Class starts at 7 a.m. Have your pit fired up & ready to GO!

"Dry camping" (regrettably, we are unable to offer electricity for this night) is available at the Farm Thursday, August 5th for School of Pit Masters attendees. Arrival must be between 5 p.m. and 9 p.m. Arrangements should be made with Lisa at eatea@comcast.net in advance.
