## Whites by The Glass

### **Verdejo – Shaya, Rueda, Spain '10**

I'm on fire about this wine. On the palate it has a creamy texture, vibrant acidity, and intense flavors leading to a lengthy, fruit-filled finish. - 10

### **Pinot Grigio – La Fiera, Veneto, Italy '10**

A delightfully fresh and crisp wine. It is both floral and fruity, expressing ripe peach and apple flavors with a subtle mineral finish. - 6

### **Sauvignon Blanc – Fire Road, Marlborough, New Zealand '10**

Classic aromas of lush tropical fruits. Clean, crisp, delicious. - 9

### **Chardonnay – NO Vineyards, Monterrey, CA '08**

No Oak. No Cork No malolactic fermentation. No attitude. No Kidding. - 8

### **Torrantes / Sauvignon Blanc – New Age, Mendoza, Argentina**

Ultimate summer wine. Delicious blend of slightly sweet and crisp. Great over ice with squeeze of lemon! - 9

### **Sauvignon Blanc/Semillon/Muscadelle – La Freynelle, Bordeaux '10**

Lovely fruity bouquet white peaches and citrus with good fruit and volume and a buttery finish. It's the bees knees. - 9

### **Gruener Veltliner – Berger, Austria '11**

Crisp and refreshing tree fruit. A favorite varietal of both Muss & Turner. Nicknamed, 'Powerade'. - 10

### **Albarino – Rias Baixas, Spain '11**

Refreshing pale golden lemon, elegant and fresh. Bone-dry with flavors of white peach, apricot, melon, pineapple, mango and honeysuckle. - 10

### **Chardonnay –Louis Latour Macon Villages Chameroy '10**

The epitome of classic white Burgundy. It possesses a fresh, creamy bouquet. - 10

### **Riesling – “Dr. Pauly” Noble House, Mosel, Germany '10**

Crisp and fine, the Dr Pauly Noble House Riesling is at once fruit and lively; pretty green apple flavors with a hint of flowers. - 9

### **Vinho Verde – Quinta de Aveleda, Portugal '09**

Summer time wine. Big aromatics. Light and dry, complex, delicate and persistent. Well balanced with tropical fruit and floral notes. - 8

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### **Blancs de Noirs – Gruet, New Mexico NV**

Yes... New Mexico. If you tasted this blind you would think it is some really good champagne. Incredible value. Sweet pastry aromas. - 8

## Reds by The Glass

### **Red Blend – Kumbaya, Sonoma, CA '10**

Campfire wine! Unpretentious yet elegant. Pleasant on the palate with no edges in the aftertaste. Sweet berries. - 6

### **Pinot Noir –Lucky Star, North Coast, CA '10**

It is very rare to find a good pinot that you can sell under \$10. Try this and you'll be impressed too. - 7.5

### **Petit Sirah – Robert Reynolds “Rocky's Block”, Lodi, CA '07**

Sultry and smooth. Concentrated as a jet pilot, wild as a rock star. Big Big Fruit! - 10

### **Cabernet Sauvignon – William Hill, Central Coast, CA '09**

Mild plum flavors with a hint of oak and vanilla. Nice tannins give a bold but drinkable structure and mouthfeel. - 8.5

### **Malbec – Llama, Mendoza, Argentina '10**

Mild plum flavors with a hint of oak and vanilla. Nice tannins give a bold but drinkable structure and mouthfeel. - 9

### **Zin / Petit Sirah – Chronic Cellars ‘Purple Paradise’, Paso Robles 10**

Unbelievably delicious. Very fruit forward with ripe raspberries and white pepper – solid and one of the best bangs for your buck. - 12

### **Pinot Noir – Domaine de la Ferrandiere '10** – Well balanced and bright fruit. Slight minerality. - 10

### **Merlot / Cabernet Sauvignon – Grand Vin de Bordeaux Chateau La Bardonne, Beaudeau '08**

Fruit forward nose, tastes of woody flowers and earth and has a voluptuous mouthfeel and a long, sultry finish. - 12

### **Grenache/Syrah/Mouvedre – Mas de Boislauzon Cotes du Rhone Villages '08**

This blend of mostly Grenache with a little Syrah and Mourvedre is a basic Chateauneuf -- juicy, ripe, a little smoky and wild. - 12

### **Sangiovese / Chiliegiole/ Canaiolo – ‘Duca’ di Saragnano Chianti Riserva, Italy '07**

A full-bodied Chianti - Sangiovese brings juicy black cherry flavors. Ciliegiole adds spicy notes. Canaiolo adds fine structure. - 11

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### **Rose – Domaine Houchart, Provence, France '10**

The wine—from Jerome Quiot, Chateauneuf superstar—is a beautiful, light pink color with lovely flavors of strawberry, raspberry, white peach and hints of almond, with a certain minerality. - 10
