SINGLE BARREL RUM, LIME, PINEAPPLE GOMME, ORANGE CURAÇAO, PEBBLE ICE *Jerry Thomas 1887*

PRESCRIPTION JULEP 10

COGNAC, RYE, MINT, GOMME, PEBBLE ICE *Prescription from "A Winter in the South" by Quakenboss, M.D. for Harper's Monthly 1857*

GIN, DRY VERMOUTH, ORANGE BITTERS *One of the first versions of the dryer style martini. "Stuart's Fancy Drinks and how to mix them" 1896*

GIN, SWEET VERMOUTH, GREEN CHARTREUSE, YELLOW CHARTREUSE, ORANGE BITTERS *Inspired by Harry Johnson 1900.*

DEVIL'S MANHATTAN 10

RYE, SWEET VERMOUTH, BOKER'S AND ORANGE BITTERS, CHAMPAGNE *Inspired by Bill Boothby and "How to Mix Drinks: Bar Keeper's Handbook" 1884.*



LAUCHLAN'S ANTISCORBUTIC 10

OLD TOM GIN, NAVY STRENGTH GIN, LIME CORDIAL, LIME JUICE, SEA SALT *In 1867 Lauchlan Rose patented a method for preserving vegetable juices after noting that sulphur salts acted a preservative agent for many perishable juices. By 1879 Rose's Lime Juice Cordial became a widespread means of obtaining well-preserved lime juice in any ship or household.*

DUPONT 9

FERNET BRANCA, SWEET VERMOUTH, BLACK TEA HONEY SYRUP, LEMON, SELTZER *Grant Street, formerly called Dupont, bridges Chinatown and North Beach, and from this we have combined Black Tea from China and Amaro from Italy.*

PROSPECTOR 10

PISCO ITALIA, ARMAGNAC, GOMME, BOKER'S AND GOLD RUSH BITTERS *During the Gold Rush, Italia Pisco was the most expensive liquor in San Francisco, nearly double in most cases compared to Whiskey, Rum, or Gin.*

CALL A TREUSE 11

GREEN CHARTREUSE, YELLOW CHARTREUSE, DRY VERMOUTH, LEMON, VANILLA SYRUP, EGG WHITE, GOLD RUSH BITTERS, THYME
As in all monasteries, at La Grande Chartreuse there was an apothecary, Brother Jerome Maubec, who served the medical needs of the monastery and the residents of the local area with remedies made from local herbs, plants, spices and other ingredients. Brother Maubec undertook the task of unraveling the ancient manuscript's complex directions for compounding the "Elixir of Long Life." Brother Antoine completed the translation of the recipe in 1737 and the monks became distillers of this medicinal elixir.

DR. CRAWFORD'S PICK-ME-UP 9

CHARTREUSE, ROOT BEER SYRUP AND BITTERS, SELTZER, PHOSPHATE CAFFEINE, AROMATIC SPIRITS OF AMMONIA *Pharmacist's Notes: NH₃ Gas is released, a mild irritant which elevates the heart rate, blood pressure, and brain activity through the Sympathetic Nervous System. CYRUS NOBLE BOURBON, GRAND POPPY, VANILLA SYRUP, ANGOSTURA AND ORANGE BITTERS, GOLD DUST *Grand Poppy: California poppy, orange, lemon, grapefruit, bearberry, California bay leaf, pink peppercorn, dandelion, blessed thistle, burdock, rue, artichoke, gentian, geranium, cherry bark, cane sugar. The three sworn enemies of the Women's Temperance Movement (Alcohol, Gambling, and Prostitution), proudly boasting their inclusion in that list as a positive for their product (Cyrus Noble).*

THE GOLDEN ERA 10

GIN, APPLEJACK, DRY VERMOUTH, LEMON, ORCHARD SYRUP, AROMATIC BITTERS *Vermouth, an aromatized fortified wine, dates back to ancient Greece from around 400 BC. A popular ingredient was wormwood, based on the belief that it was effective at treating stomach disorders and intestinal parasites. The use of vermouth as a medicinal liquor waned by the end of the 18th century, but it gained popularity in Italy and France as an aperitif. The advent of the cocktail, in the late 19th century, found a new use for vermouth.*

PARAMOUR 10

GIN, CAMPARI, YELLOW CHARTREUSE, LEMON, GRENADINE, PROVENCE BITTERS *Campari bitters is an aperitif flavored with botanical matter characterized by a bitter or bittersweet flavor. Numerous longstanding brands of bitters were originally developed as patent medicines, but are now sold as digestifs and cocktail flavorings. Many of the various brands and styles of digestive bitters made today reflect herbal stomachic and tonic preparations whose roots are claimed to be traceable back to renaissance era pharmacopeia and traditions.*

SODA Fountain



THE SODA FOUNTAIN was invented in American pharmacies as early as the 1830's as another method to make bitter medicines more palatable. The powdered or liquid medicine was added to sweet-flavored syrups to disguise the strong herbal

or chemical taste; sparkling waters were added because the bubbles were thought to have curative properties and stimulate the system. Many of today's popular sodas, including Coca-Cola, Pepsi, Bubble-Up, and Dr. Pepper were invented by pharmacists and sold as tonics.

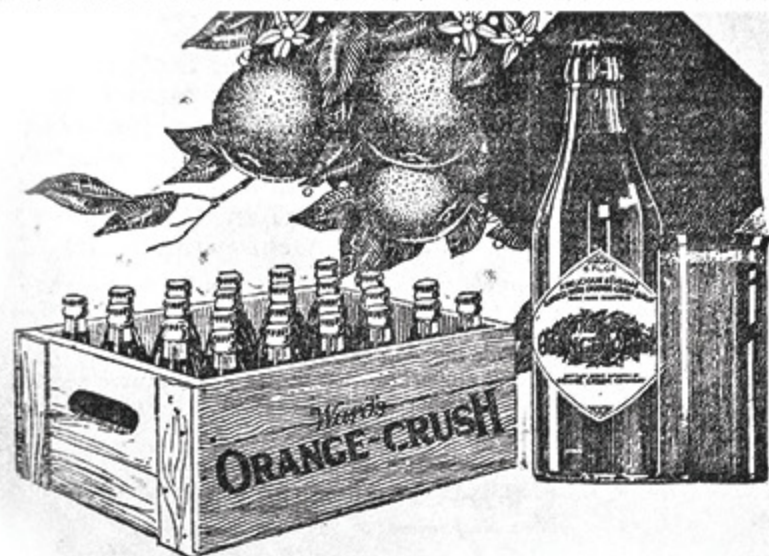
VANILLA SYRUP, ROOT BEER BITTERS, EGG WHITE, LACTART, SELTZER, PEBBLE ICE Alexander C. Howell, of New Jersey, was granted a patent for "cream soda-water" in 1865. Howell's cream soda-water was made with sodium bicarbonate, water, sugar, egg whites, wheat flour, and "any of the usual flavoring materials—such as oil of lemon, extracts of vanilla, pineapple, to suit the taste" before drinking, the cream soda water was mixed with water and an acid such as tartaric acid or citric acid. (Note: Contains trace amounts of alcohol)

LEMON-LIME 5

LEMON-LIME SYRUP, CITRIC ACID, SELTZER, PEBBLE ICE

The soft drink 7Up was originally named "Bib-Label Lithiated Lemon-Lime Soda" when it was formulated in 1929 because it contained lithium citrate. The beverage was a patent medicine marketed as a cure for hangover. Lithium citrate was removed from 7Up in 1948.

ORANGE SYRUP, PHOSPHATE, CITRIC ACID, SELTZER, PEBBLE ICE

GINGER BEER 5

GINGER JUICE, GOMME, BLACK PEPPER, CITRIC ACID, SELTZER, PEBBLE ICE During the Victorian era, ginger was used to brew an alcoholic beverage termed "ginger beer". Today, ginger beer is almost always produced as a soft drink.

AMMONIA COKE (WITH MEXICAN COCA-COLA) 6

AROMATIC SPIRITS OF AMMONIA was often used as an antacid, for America's communal case of dyspepsia in the 1800s. The mixture has a basic pH, so it neutralized stomach acid very effectively. Besides the stomach soothing application, it was used for a variety of other conditions, like nervousness, hysteria, mild drunkenness and hangovers.

AROMATIC ELIXIR 6 A concoction of citrus peels and exotic spices. Druggists of the 19th century developed these for the sole purpose of masking the often vile tasting and disagreeable flavors of medicines of the time. Similar to bitters but without the bittering agents.

SURFEIT WATER 6 Before our "modern" digestive aids, there were similar cordials (1700's) that served the same purpose. These cordials were called Surfeit Water, which were specifically created for overindulgence. They differed from Bitters, in that pharmacists and doctors provided bitters for your ill's, where Surfeit Water was provided by your saloon keeper. Now, in the 1700's, the difference between a saloon keeper and pharmacist wasn't much, and both were prone to prescribing a variety of alcohol based mixtures that were suppose to "cure what ails you".

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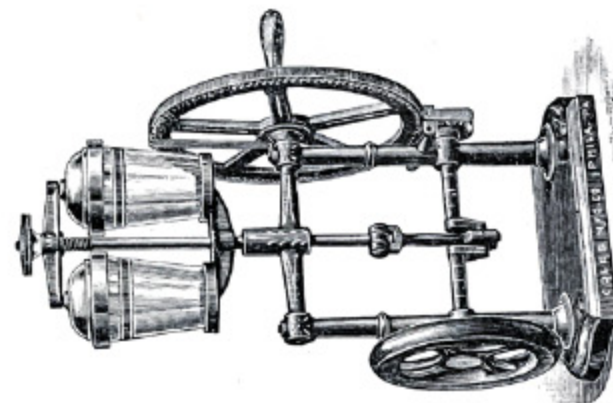
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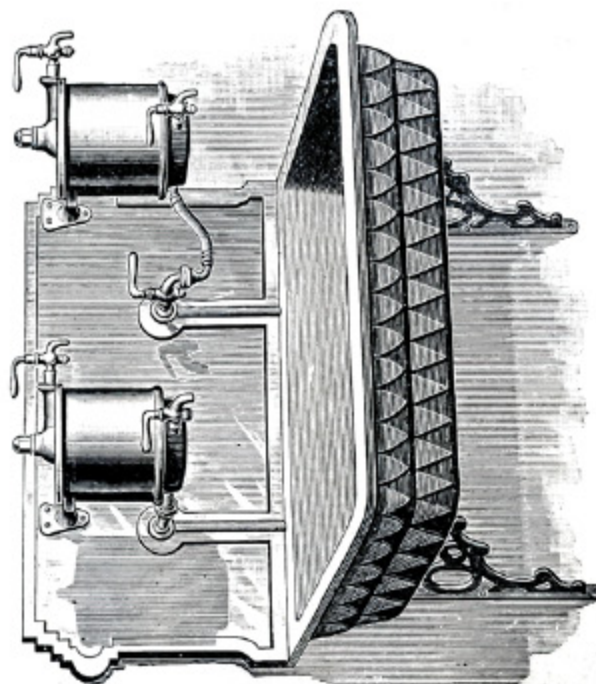
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
