

## AESOP'S FABLE OF THE THIRSTY CROW

A crow perishing with thirst saw a jug, and hoping to find whiskey, flew to it with delight. When he reached it, he discovered to his grief that it contained so little whiskey that he could not possibly get at it. He tried everything he could think of to reach the whiskey, but all his efforts were in vain. At last he collected as many stones as he could carry and dropped them one by one with his beak into the jug until he brought the whiskey within his reach. Thus he quenched his thirst and saved his life.

Aesop's Moral:  
Necessity is the mother of invention.

Whiskey (Ireland) or Whisky (Scotland), also known as 'the water of life', is a spirit distilled from grain mash.

Bourbon is an American whiskey. At least 51 percent of the grain used in making the bourbon must be corn. Bourbon must be aged for a minimum of two years in new, white oak barrels that have been charred. Nothing can be added at bottling to enhance flavor, add sweetness or alter color. You may find bourbon to be sweeter and more full bodied than rye whiskey.

Rye whiskey can refer to either American or Canadian rye whiskey. American rye must be made with at least 51% rye. Canadian rye does not have to include rye. You may find rye whiskey to be more spicy or fruity than bourbon.

Scotch Whisky must be distilled in Scotland and can be made only of water and whole barley (although caramel coloring is okay). It must be matured in Scotland in oak casks (the barrels are often pre-used bourbon barrels) for at least three years and one day. Because scotches are smoked with bricks of peat (ancient, decayed vegetable matter), they often taste smokey.

## SCOTCH WHISKY

The Scotch Whisky Association divides Scotland into different scotch producing regions:

**Lowland** whiskies emphasize the malt more than peat.

**Speyside** whiskies are characterized by rich flavor, complexity, and relatively mild character.

**Highland** whiskies carry a wide range of flavors and styles.

**The Islands**, an unrecognized sub-region, are officially part of the Highlands.

**Campbeltown** is known for a salty sweetness in its whisky. The whisky is half way between the Highlands and Islay.

**Islay** whisky is rich, iodine-flavored, very smoky, and very peaty.
