Deep golden / A pale Belgian ale, Leffe Blond is a full and creamy with hints of quince, gooseberry, bitter cherry and apple / The symbol of Leffe is the picturesque tower of the Notre-Dame de Leffe Abbey in Dinant, Belgium / 6.6% ABV

Clear & golden / Fine hop taste with subtle bitter flavor & a sweet finish / Originally a holiday beer, it gained popularity & was introduced year-round / 5% ABV

Golden blond / Hoppy aromas with hints of fruitiness, rounded off by an intense yet pleasant bitterness / Europe's Best Belgian Style Strong Pale Beer at World Beer Awards 2012 in London / 9.5% ABV

Omer — Triple Golden Ale

Blond / Subtle, fine, hop bitterness & a supple, full maltiness, dry finish / Omer is named after the name of every first born in the brewery family, Vander Ghinste for 5 generations / 8% ABV

La Chouffe — Triple Golden Ale

Unfiltered blond / Pleasantly fruity, spiced with coriander & a light hoppiness / The Chouffe logo is Albert, the bearded gnome who wears a red hood / 8% ABV

Tripel Karmeliet — Triple Golden Ale

Golden / A complex feel of crispy wheat, creamy oat & a spicy lemony dryness / Karmeliet refers to the Carmelite monks who created the recipe in the XVII century / 8% ABV

Duvel — Triple Golden Ale

Blond / Slightly fruity, dry aroma, well-hopped beer, with a slightly bitter finish / To commemorate the end of the first World War, Duvel was initially dubbed "Victory Ale" / 8.5% ABV

Westmalle Triple — Trappist Triple Golden Ale

Golden yellow / A subtle sweet note is carried by fruitiness and bitterness. The finish is long, dry and pleasantly bitter / This type of beer was first brewed in the Westmalle Abbey in 1934 / 9.5% ABV

Leffe Blonde — Abbey Blond Ale

Deep golden / A rich & warm-feeling beer with a sweet finish / The symbol of Leffe is the picturesque tower of the Notre-Dame de Leffe Abbey in Dinant, Belgium / 6.6% ABV

St. Feuillien Triple — Abbey Blond Ale

Golden blond / A sipping beer, very perfumed with a fruity hop aroma / St. Feuillien is named after an Irish monk who was martyred in the 7th Century at the village Le Roeulx / 8.5% ABV

FRUIT

Boon Kriek — Cherry Lambic

Red / Refreshing sweet-&-sour cherry taste / To brew Kriek Boon, old & young lambic beer that has aged in oak casks are used. When the lambic is 6 months old, black cherries are added / 4% ABV

Timmermans Oude Gueuze — Wild Gueuze

Golden yellow / The sour but never embittered taste is in a perfect balance. Wood tannins evoke years of ageing in oak casks / Oude Gueuze is a controlled appellation of origin, meaning it's label is certified authentic / 5.5% ABV

Timmermans Strawberry — Lambic Style - Fruit

Red / Its strawberry flavour confirms the nose's impression, without being over-sweet, and is enhanced by a real feeling of freshness, recalling those tiny green granules that are found around ripened strawberries / Timmermans is one of Belgium's oldest lambic breweries, dating back to 1702 / 5.5% ABV

WHITE

Hoegaarden — Witbier Wheat Ale

Pale, hazy yellow / A refreshing & light sweet-sour taste with a lemon & spicy coriander nose / The unique color of Hoegaarden comes from its unique brewing process; first top fermentation & then it is fermented in the bottle / 4.9% ABV

Wittekerke — Witbier Wheat Ale

Cloudy yellow / Aromatic, fruity, slightly sweet & spicy with touch of citrus / This beer was named after a successful TV soap opera / 5% ABV

Timmermans Lambicus Blanche — Belgian Style White

Yellow / By addition of spices such as coriander and dried orange zest, a beer is created with a light, fruity flavour, deliberately cloudy and subtly spicy / Should be drunk from an authentic stoneware pot / 4.5% ABV

AMBER

De Koninck — Triple Amber

Red amber / Starts malty & spicy with a dry finish / This beer was launched at the 175th anniversary of the brewery / 8% ABV

Pauwel Kwak — Triple Amber

Clear amber / Mellow, nougat-like, slightly spicy, with a sweet, delicate bitterness / The Kwak glass was designed to be used by the coachmen who where not allowed to enter the bar / 8.1% ABV

Brunehaut Bio Amber (Gluten Free) — Amber Ale

Amber Copper / Caramel malts smell with reminiscences to vanilla, toffee, butterscotch & ripe fruits / Brunehaut is the name of the paved Roman road running between Amiens, France, right down to Cologne, Germany / 6.5 % ABV

Orval — Trappist Ale

Cloudy amber / Mildly fruity with a strong hoppy aroma / The name Orval is derived from "Valley of Gold". According to the legend, a lost golden ring was recovered from the lake in the valley by a trout / 6.2 % ABV

BRUNE

Leffe Brune — Abbey Brown Ale

Deep Autumn brown / Full-bodied, fruity & sweet with notes of brown sugar, caramel & toffee. Dry, sweet finish / The symbol of Leffe is the picturesque tower of the Notre Dame de Leffe Abbey in Dinant / 6.5% ABV

Malheur 12 — Specialty Dark Strong Ale

Brown / Malty flavor. Full & round, touches of nuts, honey & rum. Bittersweet finish / A "malheur" (misfortune) can sometimes mean a bad time. But a genuine Malheur is savoured with friends & enjoyed in moderation / 12% ABV

Gulden Draak — Triple Ale

Dark red / Natural malt toffee-like sweetness & some hoppy accents / The Gulden Draak is the festive beer of the proud Flemish city of Ghent for many centuries / 10.5% ABV

St. Bernardus ABT 12 — Quadruple Dark Abbey

Dark Ivory / A full-bodied taste & a perfect equilibrium between malty, bitter & sweet / The recipe used for the Abt 12 is still one of the original recipes from the days of license-brewing for the Trappist monks of Westvleteren / 10.5% ABV

Delirium Nocturnum — Triple Dark Ale

Deep brown / Warm, velvety with a strong taste, tones of alcohol, hops and bitter rind in the aftertaste / The Pink Elephant depicted on the label fatalistically mocks the dangers of excess / 8.5% ABV

Chimay Bleue — Trappist

Dark brown unfiltered / Powerful & complex bouquet of fine spices with a shade of caramel / Chimay Bleue becomes more complex with age / 9% ABV

Rochefort 10 — Trappist Ale

Dark brown amber / Fruity sweetness, a full round body & malty hoppiness, exotic finish / "Quad" refers to the level of alcohol (6 - 8% ABV) / 7.5% ABV

FLEMISH BROWN

VanderGhinste Old Brown — Flemish Sour Red-Brown Ale

Brown red / A well-balanced, hardly noticeable Brewers, whose members have been brewing beer in Belgium for at least 50 years non- stop / 5.5% ABV

Rodenbach Grand Cru — Flemish Sour Red-Brown Ale

Red brown / A sharp sour taste, fruity, refreshing & with a balanced Madeira-like sweetness / This beer has been called a "world classic" & "the Burgundy of Belgium" / 6% ABV

Liefman's Gouden Band — Flemish Red-Brown Ale

Red brown / Dry, lightly caramelised malt flavour, enriched with fruity notes hinting at nuts or dried raisins / Originally called IJzerenband (Iron Band) – a reference to the iron bands around the beer barrels / 8% ABV

Golden blond / Flavor full of nuances & a slight tang / At the 2009 World Beer Awards, in London, Saison was voted the “World’s Best Saison Ale” / 6.5% ABV

Amber / Easy to drink & harmonious, honey-like tenderness & fruity fermentation aroma / In 1980, the Brabant draught horse appeared as the logo on the Palm label to illustrate that Palm has Brabant origins / 5.4% ABV
